What we are covering in each subject

Literacy- We are learning about writing newspaper reports and will be creating our own about the 'Knight Who Couldn't

Science- We will be looking at a range of different animals and identifying their animal group. Music- We are looking at film musical versions of traditional stories and creating our own. Art- We will be exploring the use of texture in paintings and creating a landscape using textures. <u>PSHE-</u> We are looking at ways we can stay safe.

RE- We will be identifying things that are special to us and others around us. <u>Computing</u> - We are exploring and investigating art made digitally.

Maths- We will be furthering our understanding of measurement and the different ways of measuring.
