What we are covering in each subject

Literacy- We will be looking at a range of different writing styles and approaches. We will be focusing particularly on creating atmospheric settings.

Science- Light! We are looking at how light is created and how we as human beings experience how light works through our eyes.

Music- This term we are very lucky that Mrs. Salt from the Shropshire Music Service is coming in weekly to give Elm class ukelele lessons.

Art- We will be our different craft skills and really reflecting on what art means to us as individuals.

PSHE- We will be looking at the topic 'Positive Thinking' all about encouraging children to think about how we can change our attitude towards situations around us.

MFL- This term we will learn the vocabulary so that we can become tiny little French teachers ourselves.

Computing - We are going to begin to focus on key computer skills in life such as typing quicker and being able to save and open documents.

R.E.- We will be exploring a unit around the key question 'How are different religions explored around the world?'

Maths- We will be really focusing on our place value knowledge such as knowing how to create and represent different amounts. There will also be a strong focus on learning and mastering our timetables in a range of different contexts.
