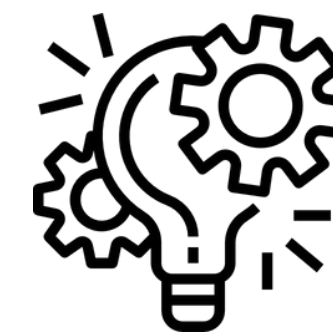




Elm class Newsletter
