Each week children will complete a maths challenge. Children will have 10 minutes to complete 50 maths calculations. Children require a minimum score of 47 out of 50 to pass. Once children have achieved 47 or above, they will move onto the next maths challenge. Children are to practise at home.

What we are covering in each subject

Literacy-Our reading and writing will be focus on the British icon-Paddington Bear. We will be learning to write a character description, narrative, and a letter.

Maths-We will be learning about place value and addition and subtraction.

Geography- We will be learning about where we live, looking at the key features around us. Science- We will be looking at everyday materials, as well as learning about seasonal changes.

Music-We will be learning about British songs and sounds.

Art-We will be exploring drawing as well as craft and design.

PSHE-We will be looking at families and relationships.

RE-We will be exploring the topic 'Who do Christians say made the world?'

Computing - We are learning about online safety.

PE - We will be learning fundamental movements and gymnastics.
