R.E.- In RE we will be looking at Christianity and what kind of world Jesus wanted.

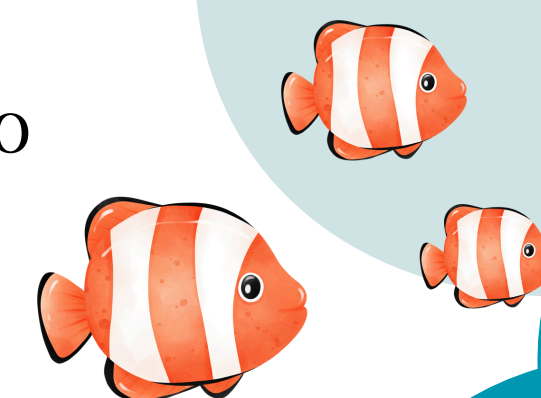
Maths-We will be really focusing this half term on place value.
