#### Welcome



#### PE and Forest School



## Our topic this term:

## **Space Explorers**



### This half term our class are going to be...

Writers (Literacy): This term we will be reading our class books 'The Boy Who Made Everyone Laugh'. We will be focusing on biographies and narrative. We will be completing Shropshire Bookfest again this year on their 'Readers to Writers' program.

**Mathematicians (Maths):** This half term we will be looking at multiplication and division, fractions and decimals.

**Historian (History):** We will be exploring how the Sikh Empire was unified by Maharaja Ranjit Singh and the values and belief system of the Sikhs.

**Scientists (Science):** We will focus on Earth and Space and the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth

**Theologians (RE):** We will be looking at what do Christians believe Jesus did to save people.

Athletes (PE): We will be focusing on Dance and Dodgeball.

**Good Citizens (PSHE):** We will be looking at how to stay safe and the changing body.

**Artists (Art):** This half term we will be covering different drawing techniques and looking at symbolism in art.

**Techies (Computing):** This half term, we will be looking at spreadsheets and data formulae in Excel.

**Linguists (French):** This term we will be focusing on how to talk about different sports in French and the French Olympics. Mrs Lawerance will also continue to teach speaking and listening through songs every two weeks.

**Musicians (Music):** We will be look at whole class instrumental lessons. We will be covering music from South America.
