## What we are covering in each subject

**Literacy-** We will be looking at a range of different writing styles and approaches. We will be writing a retelling of the story 'Egyptian Cinderella' and in guided reading we will be reading the story 'The boy who stole the Pharaoh's lunch'.

**Science-** In science we will be learning about light, how it can be reflected, and what materials reflect light.

**Music-** In music this half term we will be describing the timbre, dynamic, and textural details of a piece of music, both verbally, and through movement.

**ART-** We will be exploring Egyptian art and creating Egyptian scrolls.

**PSHE-** In PSHE we will be looking at staying safe and our changing bodies.

**MFL-** We will be learning how to count up to 31 and the months of the year in French.

**Computing** – This half term we will be looking at how to create our own logos.

**R.E.-** In RE we will be learning about how the impact of Pentecost on Christians.

**Maths-**We will be really focusing this half term on multiplication and division and area.

**History-** In History we will be looking at the Egyptians and how they lived.
